STC INTERNATIONAL SPORT EVENT OF THE YEAR AWARD GROUP B: EVENT BUDGET LESS THAN \$2 MILLION

The Sport Tourism Canada Sport International Event of the Year recognizes the overall success of an outstanding international sport event held in Canada between 2020 - 2022. The Events Rights Holder must be an International governing body/entity and a Canadian community/NSO bid against other international communities/NSOs and won the right to host the event in Canada. The event's international broadcasting/streaming reach will be a significant part of the evaluation criteria.

If you submit an incomplete form, you will not be able to go back and add or change any of the information on the online form. - Describe how this event affected local community spirit. Describe the approach to volunteer recruitment, retention, training, motivation & recognition. (MAX 250 words 10/100 points)
- Describe how this event directly contributed to a long-lasting social impact, legacy, or environmental stewardship. Please provide examples. (MAX 250 words 10/100 points)
- Please describe how the event positively affected the local sport community and the ways in which the event impacted the lives of others. (MAX 200 words - 10/100 points)

• Describe a "WOW" factor that set this event apart from other international events hosted in Canada from 2020-2022. (MAX 150 words - 10/100 points)
