ESSAY QUESTIONS:

Describe the goals and results (outcomes/performance) associated with sustainability and legacy: Max 250 words/section (20 points/section)

- Environmental Stewardship: With venues, event operations and services and ranging from waste reduction, diversion, reuse, and recycling; greenhouse gas management, energy efficiency, emissions reduction; biodiversity protection, conservation, and restoration; water quality and conservation; air quality; resource use efficiency (smart use of natural resources and materials).
- Social Inclusion and responsibility: Ranging from barrier-free accessibility in venues and services; health and safety; ethical conduct; creating opportunities for diversity, heritage conservation, arts & culture, and social inclusion; and creating community benefits.
- Economic Development: Ranging from economic impact, skills development, and job opportunities (paid, contracted and volunteer), sustainable sourcing (purchasing, licensing, merchandising, sponsorship), green building design and retrofits, innovation (new sport event related products and services), new partnerships (with large, small, and medium sized enterprises, public; private' non-profit organizations).
- Describe how engagement, communications (internal and external) supported awareness, and behaviour change vis-à-vis sport and healthy living (sport, recreation, food), increase in public transportation or self-propelled modes of transportation etc.
